## COLE MANOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL Suggested Supply List 2009 Supply Lists

The supplies listed below are for homework use as well as in class projects and are suggested lists.

### Kindergarten

- 3 Crayola washable Glue Sticks (Net Wt. 0.88 oz) or (25g)

- 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer w/pump
