

Superintendent's Report - June 2019

We concluded the 2018-2019 school year in spectacular fashion on Thursday, June 13. Elementary schools and middle schools held promotion ceremonies for students moving to the next level. At NAHS, we celebrated with 417 graduates of the Class of 2019.

This summer, the district will be expanding its summer energy conservation efforts after a successful pilot last summer. From July 1 through August 2, specific building will be closing on a schedule designed to maximize energy savings while minimizing the disruption to our summer cleaning, maintenance, and facility upgrade schedules. The exact schedule will be posted on the district website so students, parents, and community members can find when specific offices and facilities will be affected.
