



Stewart Middle School Dress Down Day

Expectations

Pants/Skirts/Shorts/Dresses

- Must be worn around the waist and must be of appropriate length and fit (no short shorts).
- Loose-fitting pants/skirts/shorts must have a belt and may not be worn in a manner exposing underwear, gym shorts, items worn as underclothing, or bare skin.
- Jeans, pants, or tops with intentionally styled tears above the knee & pajama bottoms are not permitted.
- If wearing leggings, the top must fall below mid-thigh. The top may not be see-through.

Tops

- Shirts must be longer than the beltline (bare midriff may not show when raising hand)
- Students may not wear tank tops or bralettes.
- Shirts may not show any cleavage or any portion of undergarments or sports bras.
 - Students are not permitted to wear any see-through clothing.
 - Hooded sweatshirts/sweaters may not be worn with the hoods up.
 - Gang colors or logos of any description are not permitted to be worn.

Head Covering/Accessories

- No hats or hoods are to be worn in school.
- Head Coverings may only be worn for religious or health purposes.
- Accessories, such as chains, spikes, or jewelry that could be detrimental to the safety and/or welfare of persons in the building are not permitted.
- Clothing with any gang association is not permitted.

Shoes

- Students must wear closed-toed shoes at all times.
- Sandals/flip-flops/slides, high heels, platforms, and slippers are not permitted.

Other

- Students may not wear clothing that advertises drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, weapons, or offensive language.
