

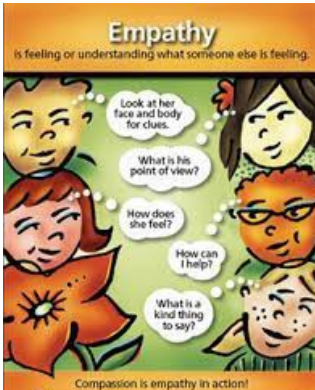


## Happy November!

Can you believe we've been in school for 44 days? We have spent those days rebuilding procedures and consistency for your children while prioritizing their mental health. We have lifted our second step program to help teach and acknowledge our motions.



**Second Step** : Our kickoff to begin teaching our new Social Emotional Learning curriculum took place on Monday, October 11th. Second Step develops a framework of social and emotional skills through the development of goal setting, decision making, emotion management, and effective communication skills. The lessons are developmentally appropriate and taught sequentially. Additionally, we will have a Parent Workshop on our new SEL program in January. If you have further questions please contact your child's teacher or Ms. Harrison our School Counselor.

**Masks**: All staff, students, and visitors are required to wear a mask. Students must wear one on the bus and throughout the school day. Please send in extra masks with your child each day. Mask breaks will be built into the schedule.

**Arrival**: Our doors open at 8:45, please do not drop your child prior to that time. We also ask that you pull all the way up past the front entrance to avoid a traffic jam on Arch Street. Please continue to give us feedback to make the morning run even smoother!

Segundo Paso: El inicio para enseñar nuestro nuevo plan de estudios de aprendizaje socioemocional se llevó a cabo el lunes 11 de octubre. Segundo Paso desarrolla un marco de habilidades sociales y emocionales a través del desarrollo del establecimiento de metas, toma de decisiones, manejo de emociones y habilidades de comunicación efectiva. Las lecciones son apropiadas para el desarrollo y se enseñan en forma de secuencia. Además, tendremos un taller para padres sobre nuestro nuevo programa en enero. Si tiene más preguntas, comuníquese con el maestro de su hijo o con la Sra. Harrison, nuestra Consejera Escolar.
